<u>Minutes.</u> Motion was made by Supervisor Hawkins and seconded by Supervisor DeFrain to approve the minutes of the September 19, 2018 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>Corporal Lacey, Pennsylvania State Police.</u> Corporal Lacey reported to the Board of Supervisors that the State Police responded to 391 calls in Warrington Township between April and September 2018. Included in that number were 24 crashes, 112 traffic stops, 4 DUI, and 39 criminal incidents. The Board said they appreciated the report.

EMERGENCY SERVICES REPORTS

<u>Wellsville Fire Company.</u> The Fire Company responded to 8 incidents in Warrington Township during the month of September 2018. Supervisor Dockery said he has been attending meetings with the Northern York Fire Service Commission who is discussing paid fire service. He said the discussion is to have paid firefighters during the day. The plan is to request a tax of up to 3 mills from municipalities to fund the service.

<u>Holy Spirit EMS.</u> The Holy Spirit Ambulance responded to 12 calls in Warrington Township during the month of September 2018.

BUSINESS AND STAFF REPORTS

<u>Chris and Kristen Arnold, 140 Wellsville Road, Wellsville.</u> Mr. and Mrs. Arnold are requesting a modification to Section 203 and 303 of the Warrington Township Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance to construct a 2,400 square foot building to be used for vehicle storage purposes. The Township Planning commission recommended approval. Motion was made by Supervisor Hawkins and seconded by Supervisor DeFrain to approve the request. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>Detters Mill Road.</u> The Township Engineer requested proposals to get quotes for repair to the damaged section of Detters Mill Road. The proposal includes removal of gabion baskets and stone from the stream bank, transport and install pre-cast concrete blocks and remove and dispose of a 36 inch diameter tree and root ball that collapsed into the stream causing blockage. Bids were received from JVI Group in the amount of \$20,100.00, Macmor Construction in the amount of \$18,210.00 and Clear View Excavation, Inc. in the amount of \$11,900.00. Motion was made by Supervisor DeFrain and seconded by Supervisor Hawkins to award the contract to Clear View Excavation, Inc. in the amount of \$11,900.00. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>Equipment discussion</u>. The new Peterbilt dump truck was undercoated for rust prevention by Krown. The Board was asked if they wished to have all the trucks treated. It was decided to wait until a full Board is present.

<u>Crack sealing</u>. The Board discussed renting a crack sealer for one week to seal around the culvert pipes that were installed this year, Poplar Road shoulders and Zeigler Road.

<u>Wellsville Municipal Authority.</u> Supervisor Dockery said Wayne Brockett has resigned from the Authority due to moving outside the Township. He has spoken with Mr. Len Kotz who is willing to take the position. The Board decided to wait until the full Board is present before making a nomination.

Motion was made by Supervisor DeFrain and seconded by Supervisor Hawkins to approve General Fund accounts payable in the amount of \$34,899.08. Motion carried unanimously.
