The meeting was opened with the Pledge to the Flag.

Minutes. Motion was made by Supervisor Hawkins and seconded by Supervisor DeFrain to approve the minutes of the January 16, 2019 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

EMERGENCY SERVICES REPORTS

Geisinger EMS. A report submitted January 8, 2019 shows 13 calls in Warrington Township during the month of December 2018. Ten were handled by Geisinger EMS. Three were handled by other EMS agencies. An invoice came into the office for the 4th quarter of 2018 charging 50 calls by Geisinger at \$35.00 each and 7 mutual aid responses at -\$75.00 each. The invoice is in the amount of \$1,225.00. The office assistant said the numbers did not add up to what was stated in the Township minutes for these months. Geisinger then changed the invoice from \$1,225.00 to \$1,200.00.

Wellsville Fire Company. The Fire Company reported responding to 11 calls in Warrington Township during the month of January 2019.

Solicitor

Ryder/Shank suit. The Solicitor reported that the appeal period has expired for this case.

Harold Stoneberger Zoning Hearing. Mr. Stoneberger's attorney requested the hearing to be scheduled for March 7, 2019.

2019 Fee Resolution. The Sewage Enforcement Officer requested some fee changes to his 2019 Fee schedule. He needs to add a fee for reconnection and for tank replacement. He also requested a raise in rates for a sewage application and perc test of \$20.00 and repair permit of \$50.00. Motion was made by Supervisor Dockery and seconded by Supervisor Weaver to ask the Sewage Officer to come to a meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

F550 plow. The snow plow on the 2001 pickup truck is getting rust holes and becoming very thin from use. The road crew would like to replace the plow on the F550 with a plow that is two feet wider and much heavier. The plow that is on the F550 can be transferred to the 2001 pickup truck. The cost of the new Western plow is quoted at \$4,875.00. Motion was made by Supervisor Hawkins and seconded by Supervisor DeFrain to approve purchase of the Western plow at \$4,875.00. Motion carried unanimously.

Summer mowing. Supervisor Hawkins is obtaining pricing for a new tractor and mower from Costars vendors. He also has spoken with a contractor from Leaders Heights Nursery regarding contracting summer mowing so that a new tractor and plow will not be necessary. Leaders Heights Nursery will stop in the Township office Monday to talk about the number of miles that will need mowed and prepare a quote.

ACCOUNTS PAYABLE

Motion was made by Supervisor DeFrain and seconded by Supervisor Weaver to approve General Fund accounts payable in the amount of \$30,377.51 and Liquid Fuels accounts payable in the amount of \$1,449.91. Motion carried unanimously.
