The meeting was opened with the Pledge to the Flag.

Minutes. Motion was made by Supervisor Weaver and seconded by Supervisor DeFrain to approve the minutes of the November 6, 2019 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

EMERGENCY SERVICES REPORTS

Geisinger EMS. The preliminary estimate of total dispatches in Warrington Township was 19 for the month of October 2019. Sixteen were handled by the Northern York Division and three were handled by a different division of Geisinger or another agency.

PUBLIC RECOGNITION

Memory Lane Bridge. All residents of Memory Lane were notified of the decision to replace the bridge. In attendance were: Bryan and Natalie Aspers, Michael and Sue Latchaw, James and Traci Meyers and David Vought. The estimated cost of the bridge replacement is \$175,735 and an additional \$19,200 for professional services. The total time of closure will be two days. The road is a dead-end road and while the bridge is closed residents will not be able to cross. The residents in attendance said they will make adjustments necessary for the time they cannot use the bridge. They said the stream is shallow and they can walk across if they can park a car on the opposite side. They asked the Board to consider maintaining the road better. The road is constantly in bad shape. If the Supervisors would keep a pile of stones along the road the residents will take care of the road themselves. They would also appreciate consideration given to the possibility of some kind of asphalt treatment to the road.

SUBDIVISION/LAND DEVELOPMENT PLANS/PLANNING MODULES

Connie Greenawalt/Martin Petratos, Spangler Road. Motion was made by Supervisor DeFrain and seconded by Supervisor Weaver to approve an extension of time for subdivision approval until April 22, 2020. Motion carried unanimously.

Harry Fox, Stone Jug Road. Mr. Fox is requesting that the Board extend the action period for his subdivision until February 20, 2020. Motion was made by Supervisor DeFrain and seconded by Supervisor Weaver to approve the request. Motion carried unanimously.

BUSINESS AND STAFF REPORTS

Thundergust Mill Road. The Engineer discussed the final accounting for the Township portion of the road with Reiff Brothers Excavating. Costs include the amount quoted for widening, reclaiming, and paving the Township portion with the Township supplying and delivering materials and additional work building the shoulder. The total outstanding balance owed by the Township will be \$19,052. Outstanding items include reinstallation of mailboxes, and 200 feet of guide rail that will be quoted by William Orr and Sons. The guide rail will need placed on the Township portion of the road.

Squire Gratz Road Bridge. The Engineer was told that this bridge should be finished in the next week.

DCNR Grant. A staff person who handles the grant program would like to meet with Township representatives to discuss the grant process. The Engineer will schedule the meeting.

2020 Budget. Motion was made by Supervisor DeFrain and seconded by Supervisor Weaver to direct the Manager to advertise the 2020 Budget as presented from the November 12, 2019 Budget meeting. The Budget does not include a tax increase. Motion carried unanimously. The 2020 Budget will be on display in the Township Office until adopted on December 18, 2019.

2019 Contributions. Motion was made by Supervisor Weaver and seconded by Supervisor DeFrain to approve payment of 2019 Contributions as presented in the 2019 Budget. Wellsville Fire Company - \$25,000; Dillsburg Senior Center and Redland Senior Center - \$1,000 each; Dillsburg Library and Annie E Sterline Library - \$500 each. Motion carried unanimously.

ACCOUNTS PAYABLE

Motion was made by Supervisor DeFrain and seconded by Supervisor Weaver to approve General Fund accounts payable in the amount of \$33,908.14. Motion carried unanimously.

ADJOURNMENT

Motion was made by Supervisor Weaver and seconded by Supervisor DeFrain to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:50 PM.
