The meeting was opened with the Pledge to the Flag.

Minutes. Motion was made by Supervisor Weaver and seconded by Supervisor Dockery to approve the minutes of the November 20, 2019 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

EMERGENCY SERVICES REPORTS

Wellsville Fire Company. The Fire Company responded to 7 calls in Warrington Township during the month of November 2019. So far this year they responded to 100 calls in Warrington Township. The Fire Chief said his drivers have been keeping a log of the traffic light preemption at Rossville. The log shows that 14 times out of 30 the preemption did not work. The Supervisors said to forward the log to PA PERCS and ask them to review.

PUBLIC RECOGNITION

Robin Crone, Kunkles Mill Road. Mrs. Crone said she would like to file a formal complaint about a problem she and other neighbors have had with goats running loose from the farm owned by Martin Petratos and Connie Greenawalt at 100 Spangler Road. The goats destroy property and are a nuisance to the neighborhood. The Codes Officer has warned the property owners to keep the goats inside a fence numerous times to no avail. She asked what they can do to have this problem stopped. Supervisor Dockery said he will research and let them know what he can find.

SUBDIVISION/LAND DEVELOPMENT PLANS/PLANNING MODULES

Robert and Katrina Updike, Detters Mill Road. The lot consolidation plan was conditionally approved during the October 16, 2019 meeting. The conditions were satisfied. York County Planning Commission sent their review letter dated November 29. Motion was made by Supervisor Hawkins and seconded by Supervisor Weaver to re-approve the Robert and Katrina Updike subdivision plan. Motion carried unanimously.

BUSINESS AND STAFF REPORTS

Thundergust Mill Road. Supervisor Dockery said the contractor for Harry Fox is working on the road shoulders repairing damage caused by heavy rain. He received a complaint from the property owner at 425 regarding water ponding at his driveway. The Engineer will relay this information to the contractor.

Squire Gratz Road Bridge. Supervisor Dockery said the bridge is now open but the road is a mess. There was report of water ponding on both sides of the bridge. The Township Engineer will contact the bridge contractor to ask when they will complete the abutments.

Rt 74 meeting at Carroll Township. There is an information gathering meeting scheduled for December 17 or December 18, 2019 at the Carroll Township building to discuss improvements for Rt 74 at Dillsburg. Supervisors from neighboring townships are invited to attend. Supervisor Dockery and Supervisor Weaver said to schedule them for the December 17th session.

Red F350 pickup truck. The truck is scheduled for sealed bid opening on December 18th. Supervisor Hawkins said there is a brand new set of springs for that truck. They can be advertised to sell also.

ACCOUNTS PAYABLE

Motion was made by Supervisor DeFrain and seconded by Supervisor Hawkins to approve General Fund accounts payable in the amount of \$61,508.46 and State Liquid Fuels accounts payable in the amount of \$610.41. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Supervisor Weaver and seconded by Supervisor Dockery to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried.
