- Sheds (this includes prefab sheds, delivered & set-up as well as stick built)
- Swimming pools-both in ground and above ground styles-fence may also be required
- Additions of any kind which you would like to add to your residence. This includes finishing off a basement
- New and replacement wells
- New driveways or additions to driveways
- Interior remodeling
- Garages, Decks, Patios, Sunrooms
- Fences
- Home occupations
- Signs
- Solar panels
- Generators

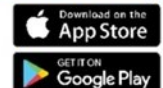

Trash and Recycling pickup day is **TUESDAY**
Large Item—1 per week

If your collection day falls on a weekday holiday, your collection day moves forward one day. If the holiday falls on a weekend, your collection day will not change.

Place waste curbside by 5 AM.
Containers may not exceed 60 lbs.

Large items that are too heavy to be lifted by two people will not be accepted.

No construction debris will be collected curbside.

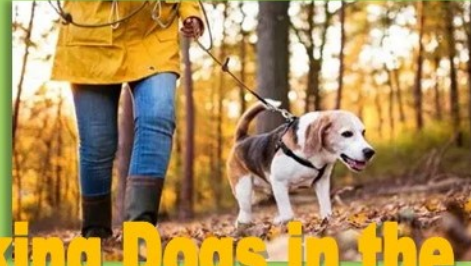

Walking Dogs in the Park

Dogs Are Permitted at Warrington Municipal Park. We ask that everyone abide by the following rules:

- Dogs must be vaccinated against rabies and display a current license.
- Dogs must be leashed at all times.
- Dogs may not be tied to trees, bushes, tables, shelter facilities, even when the owner is present.
- Dogs must be well behaved at all times.
- Dog owners are required to pick up after their pets and properly dispose of all pet dropping in trash receptacles.
- Pets may not create a disturbance or nuisance. Excessive barking is a disturbance. Owners may be asked to remove dangerous or noisy pets from the park.
